Important information:

- Entry deadline is Friday July 12, 2024. Please be prompt. Completed forms can be sent of emailed to HOVmiddleton@gmail.com
- Float dimensions are restricted to 36 feet long, 8 feet wide, and 12 feet high unless special permission is given by the Department of Motor Vehicles
- Absolutely no one is able to operate a motor vehicle (ie motorcycle, tractor, car, atv, etc) without proper licensing
- In the even of a mechanical breakdown along the parade route the entry must be with withdrawn from the line-up immediately
- Fire/emergency apparatus are to refrain from using the sirens or hose during the parade
- Due to safety concerns, food or other objects cannot be thrown from the floats or vehicles. Walkers may go alongside your entry and hand out these items.
- Confirmation and position numbers are not sent out to entries. If you require this information prior to the parade, please email HOVmiddleton@gmail.com
- Judging will take place at the Rotary Park. Winners will be notified before the parade ends.
